

Albin Pintar – Short CV



Dr. Albin Pintar, Research Professor, is head of the Laboratory for Environmental Sciences and Engineering at the National Institute of Chemistry, Ljubljana, Slovenia. He obtained his M.Sc. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Ljubljana in 1992 and 1996, respectively. He was a visiting scientist at the Tokyo Institute of Technology (Japan) and Research Institute of Catalysis and Environment (Villeurbanne, France). His research interests are in the fields of heterogeneous catalysis, environmental catalysis, kinetics and mechanisms of catalytic reactions in multiphase reactors, wastewater treatment, production of hydrogen rich mixtures from renewables and process intensification. He is the author of over 150 scientific papers and review articles in peer-reviewed journals, and several international patents (*h*-index: 40). In 2011, he received a prestigious national award for significant scientific achievements in chemical engineering. Albin Pintar is president of the Slovenian Chemical Society and serves as associate editor to *RSC Advances*.
